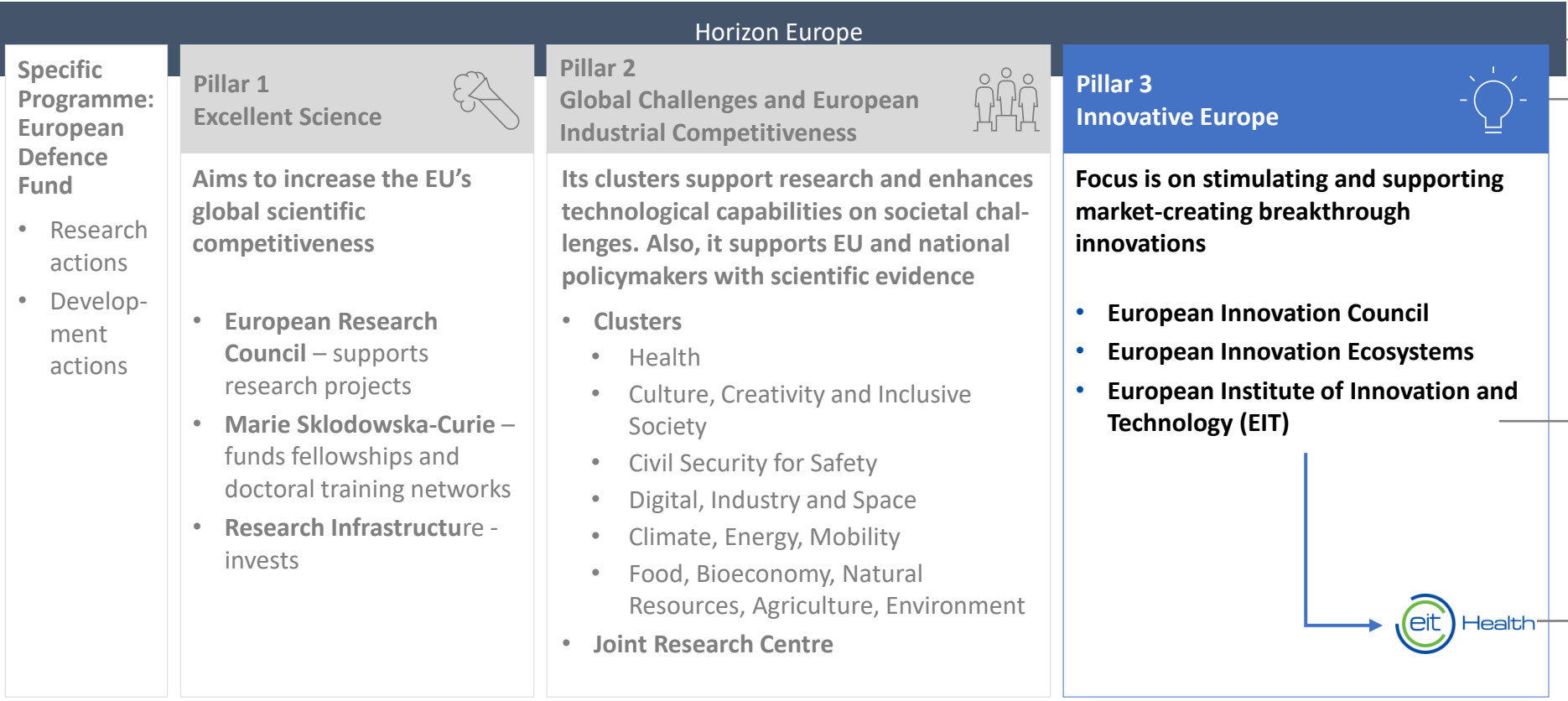
The European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT) at a glance

The EIT is an integral part of Horizon Europe, the EU's Framework Programme for research and innovation

Main goals

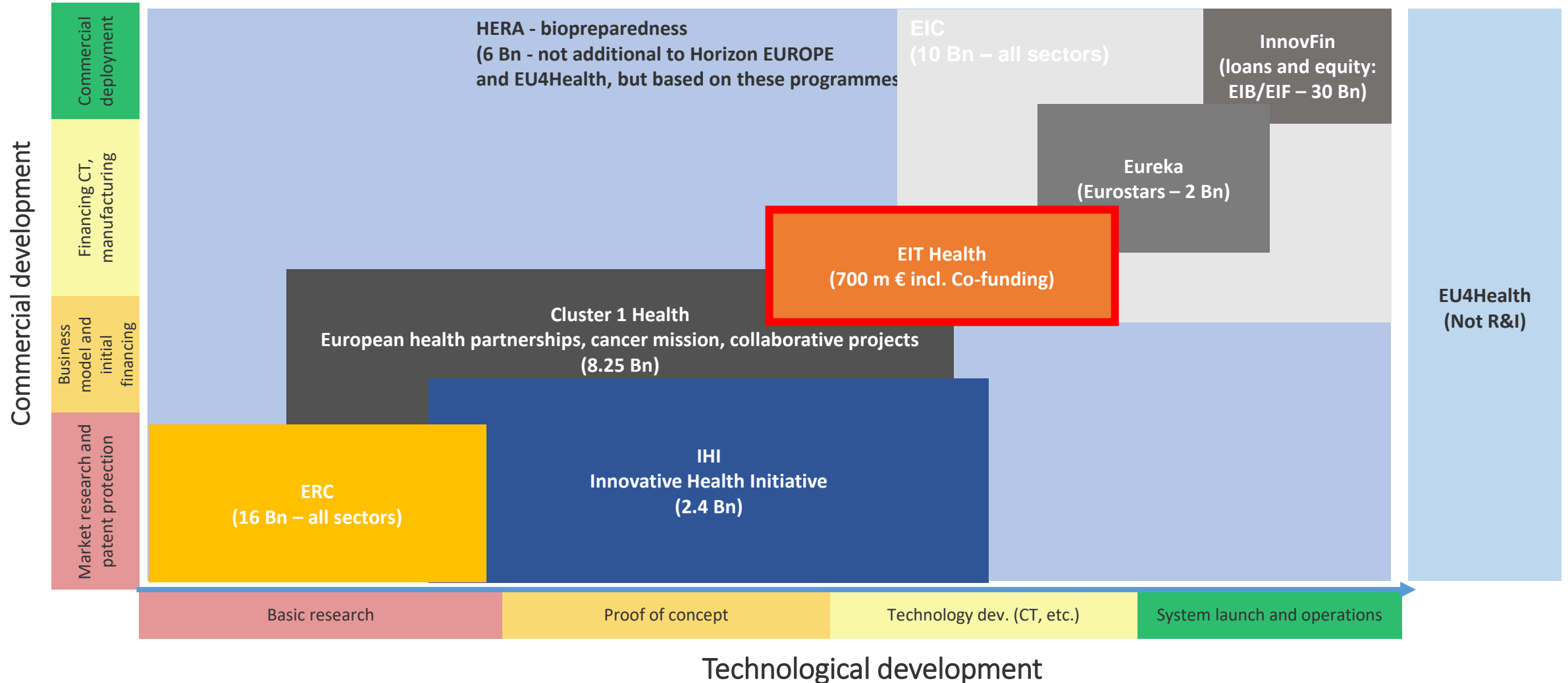
- Strengthen scientific and technological base

Horizontal Pillar: Widening participation and strengthening the European Research Area



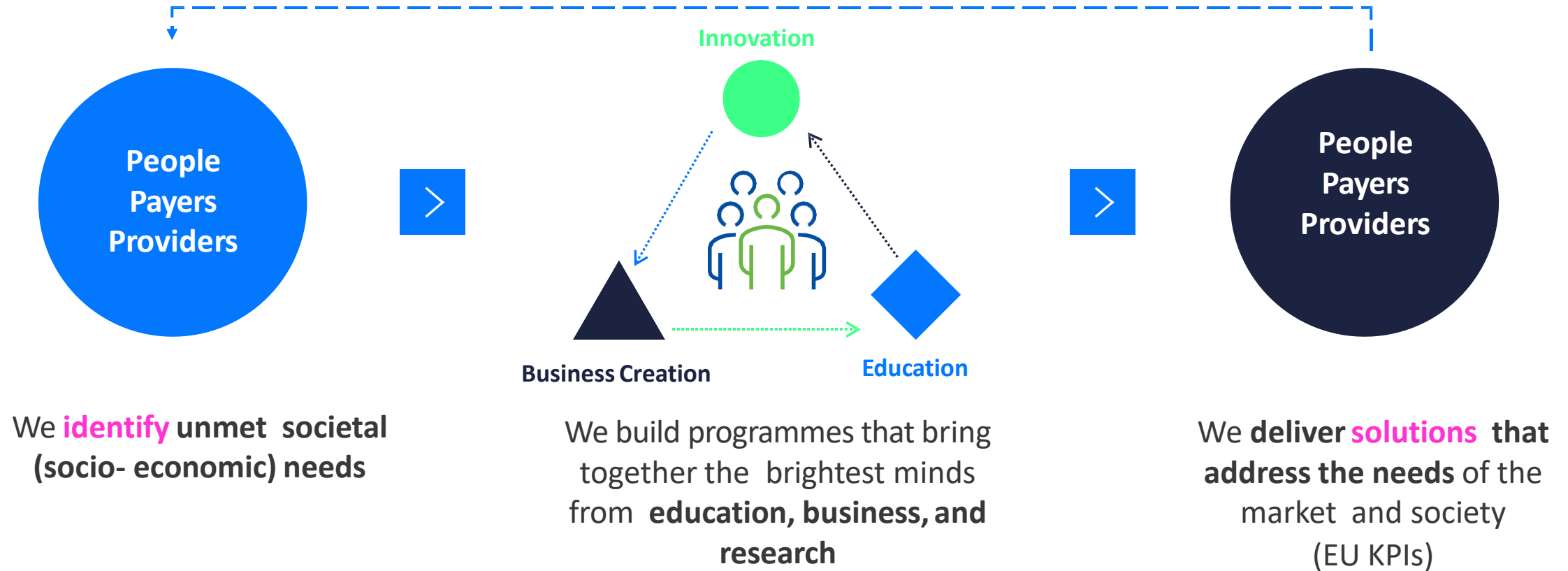



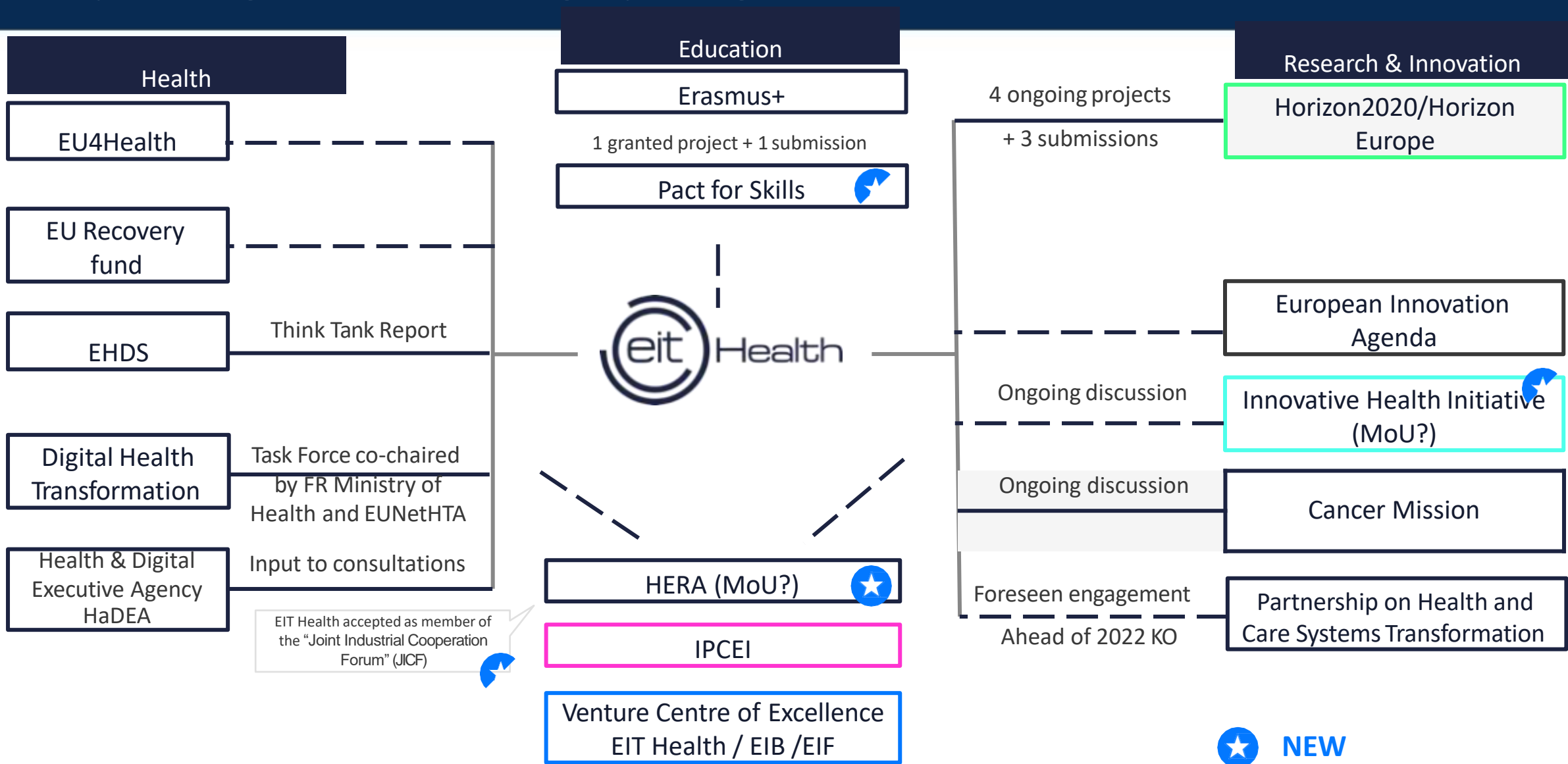
